



Print Portal Instructions


1. Website: https://frp.printville.net/. First time users will need to create a new account. Use your company email address.




2. You will be greeted with the following page. You will want to click on the 'Acentria' tab.

4. Click 'Acentria Business Cards'






5. You will have the option of a horizontal or vertical card.






6. Once selected, click 'NEXT'.







7. Fill in your information on the left side. Click 'Update Preview' to see a proof of your card. Once done, click 'Finish Editing'.



8. Check your card over once more to ensure there are no errors. Once done, approve the document and click 'Add to Cart'.




9. Click 'CHECKOUT'



10. Select your correct business unit, and click 'COMPLETE ORDER'











1) Once you select the product you're interested in, you'll see the following screen:




2) After clicking 'Next,' enter your information on the left-hand side:




3) At the bottom, you will be prompted to add in your headshot:
